## **Compound Sentence Formulas:**


- 1. Have 2 or MORE independent clauses (usually only 2)
  - Remember that an independent clause is a simple sentence
- **2.** I= an independent clause

## **3.** I, cI or I;I (c= coordinating conjunction)

- These are the ONLY two ways to place independent clauses together in a sentence!
- Each Independent clause MUST have a subject and a verb.
