

Everyone shares out their walk up song.

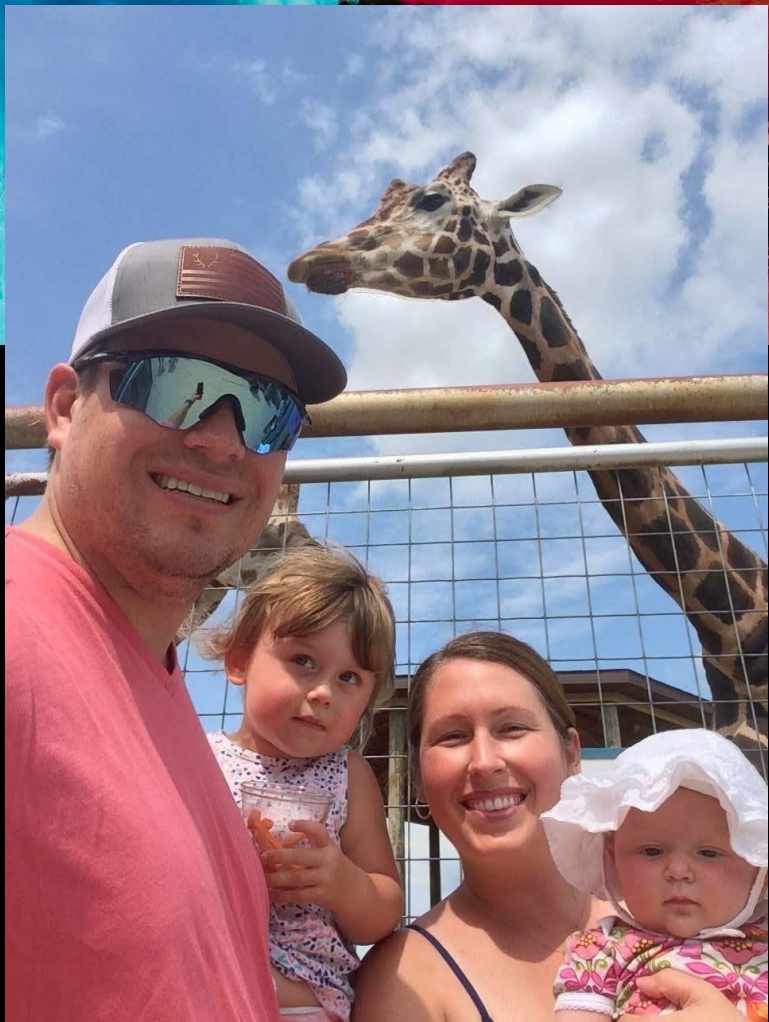


