Making a visual aid, not a script

The Rule of Five...

Dictates how many items you can have per slide
 I.e. five or fewer
 Items = title, bullet points, pictures, etc.

1. Title

2. Bullet point
3. Bullet point
4. Bullet point

5. Picture



What to Include on a Slide

- Little bits of information
 - Fragments are acceptable
 - Avoid using periods
 - One piece of info per bullet point

What to Include on a Slide

• Don't do this:

 The University of Westminster is approximately 3,821 miles from Grand Rapids, MI. It takes about 8.5 hours to get there via airplane with an additional hour of travel by train.

• Instead, do this:

- Approximately 3,821 mi from Grand Rapids, MI
- 8.5 hours via airplane + 1 hour via train

What to Include on a Slide

• Pictures

- Make sure they're relevant
- Legible font

The most important thing: Make sure your visual aid is just an aid (if you read directly off of it, you will lose points).
