Must include:

- Book Title (italicized)
- Author's last name
- Response to prompt
 - Focus on the last/overall question (typically about the significance or the message)

Examples:

- 1. Dystopian Elements
 - a. In *To Kill A Mockingbird*, Lee utilizes dehumanization as a dystopian element to emphasize to readers that people who dehumanize others end up being viewed as inferior themselves.
- 2. Dystopian Controls
 - a. Lee includes philosophical control in her novel To Kill A Mockingbird to illustrate that allowing outdated ideologies to control one's actions causes one to lose his or her humanity.
- 3. Dystopian Protagonist
 - a. It is through the eyes of Scout in Lee's *To Kill A Mockingbird* that readers come to understand the negative impact of racism and classism in Depression-era Maycomb and in the world today.
